

## ENCAMPMENT EQUIPMENT PACKING LIST

Use this list to prepare and pack for encampment. These uniform requirements are the **MINIMUMS** (unless otherwise stated). Please do not attend encampment without the quantities listed below. All of your items **MUST** be marked with your last name in some way. Uniforms and undershirts should be marked on the shirttail. Underpants should be marked on the waistband. Uniform pants should be marked on the product label. **YOU WILL NOT HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO PURCHASE THESE ITEMS AT ENCAMPMENT.** It is recommended that you arrive with your uniform pressed and cleaned. Place a checkmark next to each item as you prepare for encampment.
